- A **Liability/Medical Release Form** must be completed by all campers under 18 who attend Midwest Camp without a parent present.
- All campers must read the **Guidelines** and sign the registration form.

Guidelines

- We are guests at FAHOLO. Appropriate behavior is expected of all those attending Midwest Camp.
- Any camper whose behavior is deemed to be inappropriate by the camp staff will be subject to dismissal from the camp grounds.
- Repair of damages to rooms or property will be the responsibility of those causing the damage.
- Proper modest attire including shoes (no bare feet) is to be worn at all times (no bikinis or tummy-baring apparel).

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Housing

- **Conference Center** – hotel-style rooms with private bathrooms and linens included. Due to the limited number of rooms, no single occupancy is available. Full-time adults and families with young children only.
- **Dorms** – bunk beds with community bathrooms. Rooms sleep from 4 to 16 people. Linens are not included. Family/adult dorms are separate from teen dorms.
- Children entering the 7th grade and under will room with their parent(s) or guardian.

Part-Time Attendees

- Priority housing is given to full-time attendees on a first-come, first-serve basis. (Please note that Conference Center housing is only available to campers attending all week.)
- If you are staying part-time in a Dorm, meals are included (see "Weekend Rates" in chart above). If you are camping or staying off-site at a hotel, you may purchase meals separately.
- Attendees staying off-site are required to pay a fee of \$10 per day for the use of Faholo facilities.
- **The \$40 flat-rate Program Fee is required for all attendees staying in a tent, RV, or off-site.**

Bed Linens and Towels

- Bed linens are included in the registration fee only for those staying in the Conference Center. These include sheets, blankets, pillows, and towel sets.
- Bed linens and towels can be rented at \$10 per set and include sheets, pillow, blanket and one set of towels. Order above under "Additional Fees."

What to Bring, Not to Bring

- Bring your Bible, notebook, pens/pencils, flashlight, bug spray, umbrella, hangers, beach towel, sunscreen, lawn chairs. Some recreational activities require closed-toe shoes.
- Dorms: pillows, sleeping bag or bed linens (XL-twin), blankets, towels (unless renting).
- Any items your younger child(ren) may require (stroller, crib, etc.).
- No cooking appliances or open flames (candles) are allowed.
- The possession, sale, or use of tobacco products, alcohol, fireworks, or illegal drugs is prohibited.

Recreation Facilities

Registration fees include access to: indoor and outdoor pools, beachfront (swimming, blob, water trampoline), canoes, paddle boats, ropes course, zip-line, climbing wall, go-carts, basketball, baseball, volleyball, disk golf, fitness center, horseshoes, and fishing (bring your own pole & bait).

Laundry

- There are no laundry facilities on site, but there is a Laundromat in Grass Lake about 5 minutes away.
- Conference Center towels are laundered per request.
